to AAUW, Post Office Box 503, Anacortes, 98221. Each year we set a goal of at least \$500, so that we may designate an honoree. Spouses and guests are welcome.

The Legal Advocacy Fund works at the national level to challenge sex discrimination in the workplace and in higher education. Unfair pay, pregnancy discrimination, sexual harassment, sexual assault, and violations of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 are issues that many women and men face today. LAF addresses these barriers by informing people of their rights and by assisting people who are using the legal system to seek justice and change.

Proceeds may go to STEM awards, scholarships, or, as we have determined this year, to cover additional branch operating expenses due to the increase in dues.
